The Commissioning of Kerowagi District Administration Office by the Prime Minister and witnessed VIPs and supported by other District MPs of Simbu Province.



The Prime Minister, Hon. James Marape, MP was invited to officially open the Kerowagi District Development Authority office complex. This was the first time a Prime Minister of PNG came to Kerowagi District.

Hon. Francis Kikin Siune, MP with his "less talk, more action" leadership finally had the district office commissioned by the Prime Minister on the February 5th, 2023.

During the occasion, the Prime Minister announced that he will be supporting the district's projects such as the Koronigle to Kerowagi road upgrade, Kerowagi-Bari & Gembogl road upgrade, ITC equipments for Kerowagi Secondary School, centralization of teacher's payroll system under ALESCO and E-learning learning facilities for primary schools among others.


